2011 National Bike It Competition included 828 schools racing virtual miles all over the whole of Britain, 606,919 healthy biking trips recorded between 7-25 March alone! In our area, 12 schools took part completing 14, 616 bike trips to school. **Epiphany School in Muscliffe** completing first and finishing 16th Nationally to win a fabulous day prize with Rollapaluza Roller Racing from London. - The school run has been a more fun filled affair this March, with the amazing involvement in **Big Pedal** shown above, lots of healthy scooting and walking all helping promote a healthy social environment around the school gates.
- St Katharines took 3 groups of year 3 children on a ride to Hengistbury head, some of whom had never ridden local roads before in their lives.
- Hamworthy firsts' brilliant scheme of work included 12 separate playground sessions across all year groups at the school.
- 3 schools gained Bronze this term, Hamworthy First, St Marks Primary and Talbot Combined.
- Silver Schoolmark work continues apace, with literacy work on cycling at Epiphany Primary and Lunch club activities at Kings Park Primary to name just two.
- Jason passed his level 2 British Cycling Assessment.
- 5 Bike It schools are close to the new velodrome, 3 visits arranged for summer term.
- Recruiting new schools for 2011/ 2012 is underway.
